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# Curriculum Enrichment

- Runs in Year 12
- Includes the EPQ (Extended Project Qualification) and Core Maths, both Level 3 qualifications equivalent to half an A-Level and highly valued by universities

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# Entrance Requirements

## General Entrance Requirements

1. A grade 4 and 5 in English (Language or Literature) and Maths
2. A Best 8 GCSE Score of 35 (an average grade of 4 at GCSE)

## Subject Entry Requirements

Each subject has its own set of entry requirements, which must be met in full. These can be found on the Sixth Form website and by using the QR code.



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# Application Process

- Applications should be made after students have received their mock exam results
- Applications are open from the Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2023 to Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024
- All students pick either 3 or 4 subjects at A-Level or BTEC, and 2 reserve choices
- Some combinations of subjects are not allowed
  1. BTEC Business, A-Level Economics, A-Level Business Studies
  2. A-Level English Literature, English Language & Literature
  3. BTEC Sport & Exercise Science, A-Level PE





# Application Process

- The application form is a detailed Google Form completed once
- Conditional offers are made in writing in April, and confirmed on results day in August
- Students complete specific induction tasks over the summer which are introduced at the transition day in late June
