Welcome to the Queens' School 100 club

The Queens' School 100 Club is a great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter!

Here's how it works...

- Complete and sign the attached membership form and return it with payment or proof of payment to Francesca Dresner, Fundraising & Marketing Co-ordinator in the Accounts Office or to dresnefr@queens.herts.sch.uk
- There are 3 ways to pay
 - By cheque for £24 payable to Queens' School Bushey
 - Via Wisepay - please go to the Fundraising section
 - Set up a standing order of £2 a month with your bank or on your banking app using the following details:

- This buys you one membership number (that we will allocate), which enters you into the monthly draw.
- The draw will take place on 15th of each month (or the closest working day to this date) starting 16th September 2024.
- If you win, the payment will be made to you via BACS and the name of the winner published in the school's monthly newsletter and on our Instagram and Facebook pages.
- The prize money will be 50% of the month's contributions per month but in December this will be 75%. The actual amount will be published once all members are signed up.
- The remaining money goes to the school to help fund equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.
- All participants must be over 18.

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Queens' School 100 Club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the Queens' School 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Queens' School bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

1. Sales of tickets finish at Midnight on Wednesday, 11th September, 2024.
2. For £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 100. Each entry is allocated a unique number which is recorded on the entries log.
3. Payments must be made by cheque, Standing Order or via Wise Pay annually. No number will be allocated until confirmation of this payment has been confirmed by the Fundraising Department.
4. A draw will be made every month with the randomly chosen number winning 50% of that month's contributions, except in December when the prize will be 75%. The final prize-winning amounts will be confirmed once all Members are signed up.
5. The draw shall be made by the headteacher on the 15th of each month (or the closest working date to this). The draw is made by using <https://www.random.org/> to pick one number at random from the total number of entries.
6. Members can purchase as many numbers as they wish for £24 per number and receive priority for the following years' number allocations.
7. Prize-winners will be contacted by the Fundraising Team for their bank details within 5 working days of the draw and payment made by BACS within 7 working days of receiving the details.
8. The name and winning number for each month's winner will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school's social media pages.
9. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff, friends and families of Queens' School. Anyone aged 18 or over can join.
10. The 100 Club will be run by the Fundraising Department. In case of any dispute the decision of the Headmaster is final.
11. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into school funds after six months.
12. If more than 100 people sign up to the Club then additional numbers will be allocated and the prize will increase but shall always be 50% of the month's contributions and 75% in December.
13. Registered under the Gambling Act 2005 with Hertsmere Borough Council, Licence Number 182
