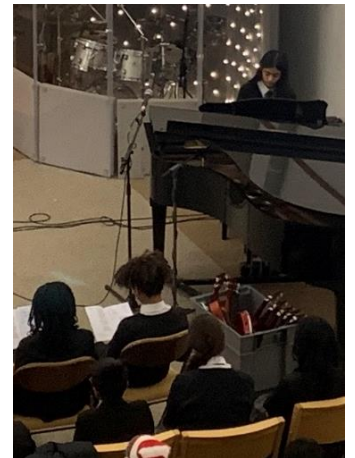




Dare to be Musical

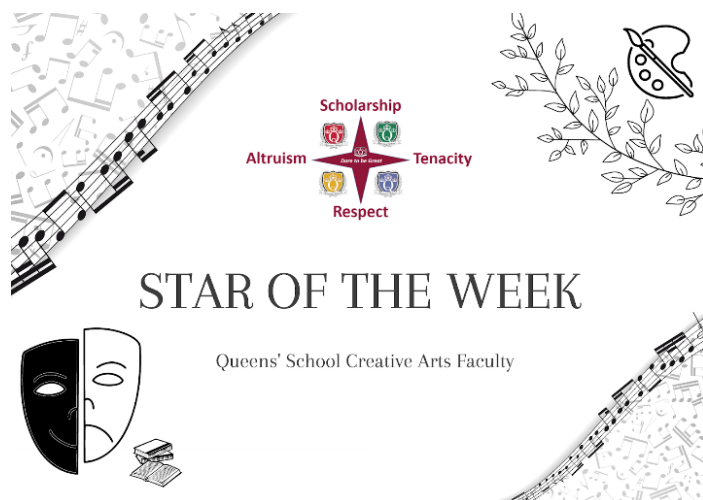
