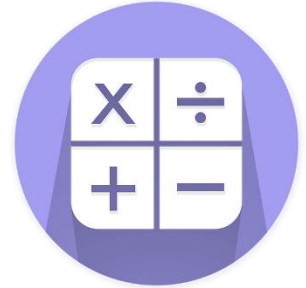
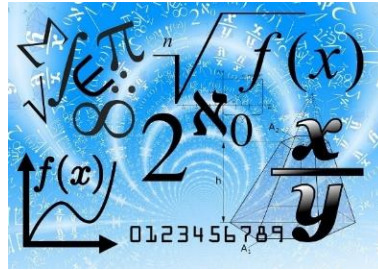




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MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT

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Year 9 Trip to the Mathematical Institute Oxford

On Monday 8th January some Year 9 girls were invited to attend the 'It all Adds up' Maths workshop at the Mathematical Institute at Oxford University. The day was organised by Oxford university to inspire women continue to study Maths for further education. They listened to a number of lectures given by Oxford University Professors which included Maths in the foundation of Space travel, Maths in a 'Chocolate Fountain' and how maths is used across different careers e.g Forensic Science. During the day they also took part in a hands-on workshop led by university students where they worked in small groups to solve different maths problems. At the end of the day they had the opportunity to ask students any questions they had on Life as a maths student and what inspired them to study maths further.

about different formulas and how things that seem quite simple have a deep maths equation behind it (like a chocolate fountain)" Lanni

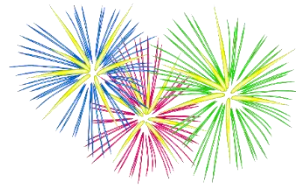

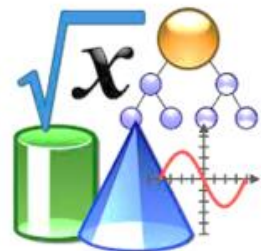
