






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MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT

Our year 7 and 8 students competed in the Herts for Learning Maths competition.







TEAM QUEENS' SCHOOL

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
On Wednesday 31st of January UKMT Intermediate Maths Challenge took place. This is a national competition for students in Years 9, 10 & 11 and is very well regarded amongst educational settings. As the challenge can be quite difficult, we usually enter Year 10 & 11 students only, however this year we opened the challenge to Year 9 too, who could opt to take part. This is a fantastic opportunity for the students who enjoy a challenge and our Year 9 students performed really well. We had 32 Year 9 students take part, and of these, 8 students achieved a silver award and a further 8 achieved a bronze award. A huge well done to Dharmakeerti who achieved the highest score in Year 9. Congratulations to all other students who accepted and took part in the challenge in Year 9 too.

In Year 10 both Luna & Izzy did fantastic by achieving gold awards, with Luna gaining a place on the Pink Kangaroo round. We also had 21 students achieve a silver award and 39 achieve a bronze award in Year 10 so congratulations to all of those students.

Yash, Yi-Lang, Yaseen & Alex in Year 11 all represented Queens' at the Pink Kangaroo round on Thursday 21st of March by achieving Gold awards in the Intermediate Maths Challenge and we are currently awaiting their results. Of the 17 Year 11 students who opted to take part in the challenge, 4 achieved gold, 3 silver and 6 bronze. Well done to all, we are a very proud maths department.

AMSP Year 10 Enrichment Trip

On Friday 5th of January a group of 20 Year 10 students headed to Hertfordshire University for a maths enrichment day hosted by the Advanced Maths Support Programme (AMSP). The day was filled of team building activities and group work with other schools, maths lectures on the maths involved in video games and mathematical braiding, and exploring post-16 options for students with an interest in maths. The mathematical braiding was a firm favourite for our students, however we were extremely proud of how well our students participated in the team quiz when taken out of their comfort zone and placed in teams with other schools. The aim of the quiz was to answer as many mathematical questions as possible correct to collect dragon parts.
