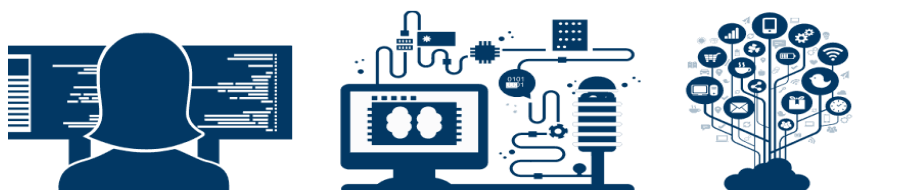

Year 11s

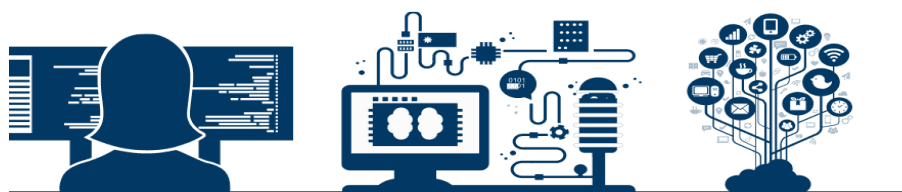
The GCSEs are getting very close now for our Year 11 students. In the new term they will be following a course of structured revision prior to going on study leave.
