Our Sixth Form students had the opportunity to experience university life with a taster day at Oxford Brookes University, focusing on 'The Built Environment'.

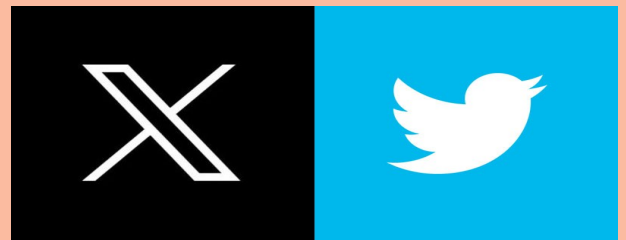
- **International Women's Day:**

We celebrated International Women's Day with school-wide activities, and a group of our girls visited Macfarlanes Law Firm in London for an inspiring experience.

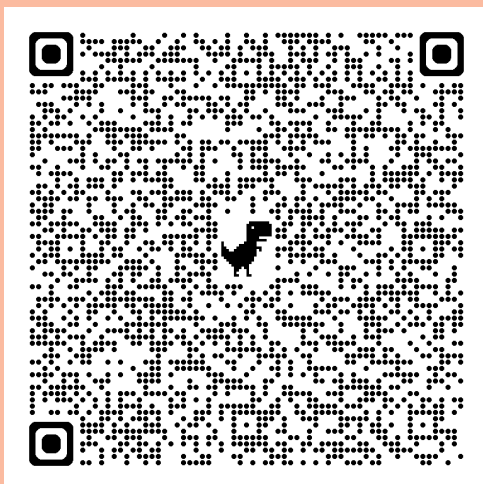
- **Queens' Den Winners at Wicks Head Office:**
