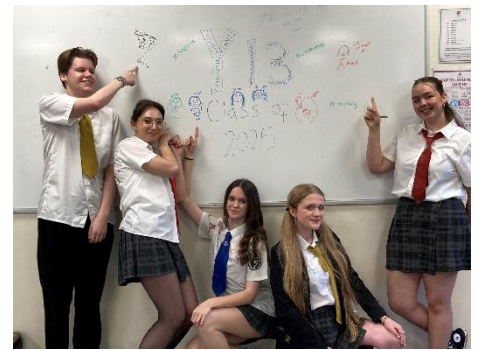




**QUEENS' SCHOOL**
