

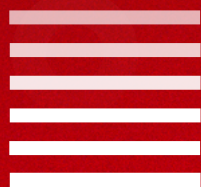

Admission to the Sixth Form will be for any student who meets the minimum academic standards:



≡ At least a grade 4 in English (Language or Literature) and 4 in mathematics.

≡ A minimum GCSE Best 8 Point Score of 35.

All students must also meet the specific entry requirements for the subjects they wish to study. The PAN for external students is 50.

At Queens', we take great pride in delivering the best academic provision for our students and we encourage all of our students to progress into full time employment, further education or apprenticeships. Our recent Ofsted report in March 2025 was rated 'Outstanding'.

To prepare our students for life post-18, we cultivate their academic interests whilst providing opportunities for physical education, enrichment, sustained contact with universities, student volunteering and leadership.
